

EDUCATION FOR CLINICAL SUPERVISION

1. How long does my supervisor (for clinical supervision) have to be licensed in order to supervise?

LP	2 years (except LMLP's – 0 years)
LCMFT	2 years
LCPC	2 years
LCP	2 years
LSCSW	0 years for social work 2 years for all other professions

2. Can I back date my training plan if I started working before my plan got approved?

No, hours towards the clinical license cannot be counted until after the training plan is approved by the board office.

3. If I am working out of state can I get an approved training plan in Kansas?

If the supervisor is licensed in Kansas then, “Yes”. If the supervisor is not licensed in Kansas then “no”, because Kansas does not have jurisdiction over out of state supervisors. The applicant will have to make application as an out of state licensee, once they have met the requirements.

4. Who is responsible for submitting the training plan?

It is the supervisee's responsibility to submit the training plan for approval, not the supervisor.
