Questions

1. How long does my clinical supervisor have to have been licensed in order to supervise?

LP	0 years to supervise a LMLP
	2 years for all other accepted professions
LCMFT	2 years
LCPC	2 years
LCP	2 years

2. May I back date my training plan, if I started working before my plan was approved?

No, hours towards the clinical license may not be counted, until after the training plan is approved by the board office.

3. If I am working out-of-state, may I get an approved training plan in Kansas?

If the supervisor is licensed in Kansas then, "Yes". If, the supervisor is not licensed in Kansas, "No". Kansas would not have jurisdiction over the out-of-state supervisor, unless, the supervisor is licensed in Kansas. After completion of the out-of-state supervised work experience the licensee would then make application for a clinical license as an out-of-state applicant.

4. Who is responsible for submitting the training plan?

It is the supervisee's responsibility to submit the training plan for approval, not the supervisor's.

5. Do changes in the training plan need to be approved by the Board?

Yes, the Board must be notified of changes in the training plan within 45 days after the change occurs. Otherwise, the accrual of supervised hours will cease until such time as changes have been approved.
