

65-6605. Advisory committee; purpose; composition; expenses; expiration.

The board shall appoint an advisory committee for the purpose of assistance in adopting rules and regulations pursuant to this act. The advisory committee shall be composed of 3 members who are registered alcohol and other drug abuse counselors under this act or are qualified for registration as alcohol and other drug abuse counselors under this act.

Members of the advisory committee shall receive amounts provided for in subsection (e) of K.S.A. 75-3223 and amendments thereto for each day of actual attendance at any meeting of the advisory committee or any subcommittee meeting authorized by the advisory committee, and such amounts shall be paid from the behavioral sciences regulatory board fee fund. The provisions of this section shall expire on the date the original permanent rules and regulations of the board become effective.
